


Programming

- ▼ Java, BASIC...




Code Reading

- ▼ Git, grep → Code management & search
- ▼ Glade → Interface design



Let's Start


- ▼ Get & build the source code
- ▼ Choose a problem/bug to solve
- ▼ Find the relevant code segment
- ▼ Dig deeper
- ▼ Test the changes
- ▼ Submit patch

Get & Build the Source Code

```
git clone https://gerrit.libreoffice.org/core libreoffice
```



```
sudo apt-get build-dep libreoffice
```



```
./autogen.sh  
make
```




```

```

IDE Integration

make & make check



make qtcreeator-ide-integration

- ▼ *Code completion*
- ▼ *Go to definition, find usages*
- ▼ *Switch between header and source easily & quickly*
- ▼ *Integrated debugging*
- ▼ *Familier interface*
- ▼ *...*

 - ▼ *git grep "a string on a dialog"*

- ▼ *IRC*
 - ▼ *#libreoffice-dev @ freenode*

Dig deeper...

▼ *Enable debugging*

```
./autogen.sh --enable-debug  
make  
make dev-install
```

▼ *Run with GDB*

```
cd [lo-root]/install/program  
. ./ooenv  
gdb ./soffice.bin  
(gdb) run
```

Test the changes

- ▼ *Rebuild a single module*
make [module-name]
- ▼ *Run tests/checks*
make check
- ▼ *Run & check manually*

Submit the Patch

- ▼ Register on gerrit, and complete the setup
 - ▼ <https://wiki.documentfoundation.org/Development/gerrit>
- ▼ Commit the changes
 - git commit***
- ▼ Submit to gerrit
 - ▼ ***./logerrit submit master***
